Awareness and Utilization of PM eVIDYA Channels for Enhanced Learning Resources.

PM eVIDYA is an initiative launched by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, to facilitate digital learning and ensure equitable access to quality education. Under this initiative, 12 dedicated DTH TV channels have been made available, each catering to students from Classes 1 to 12. These channels, managed by NCERT and CBSE, provide curriculum-aligned educational content that is accessible via DD Free Dish, cable TV networks, and online platforms such as DIKSHA and NCERT's official website. The objective of PM eVIDYA is to bridge the digital divide and enable students across different regions to continue their learning seamlessly.

The State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Delhi, requests all schools under the Directorate of Education (DoE), Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), and New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) to ensure that students, parents, and guardians are made aware of the PM eVIDYA channels.

All Heads of Schools (HoS) and teachers are directed to inform students about these channels and encourage them to use the resources effectively. These channels offer subject-wise educational content aligned with the curriculum and can be accessed through DTH, cable networks, and online streaming.

These channels are available on DD Free Dish and various cable TV networks, as well as via online platforms such as DIKSHA and NCERT's official website. (<https://ciet.ncert.gov.in/initiative/pmevidya>)

All schools under the Directorate of Education, MCD, and NDMC must disseminate this information widely among students and parents to facilitate access to these valuable learning resources.
