Also, as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India (GOI), starting from the academic year 2024-25, students applying for Pre-Matric and Post-Matric SC Scholarships are required to complete the One-Time Registration (OTR) process on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP).After obtaining the OTR number, applicants may proceed with their scholarship application on eDistrict portal and submit the OTR number along with other. The detailed end-to-end process for completing the OTR is outlined in the attached document. 3. Post Matric Scholarship for SC students

Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC have taken over implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship to the students belonging to SC category for pursuing further studies at post matriculation / post secondary (College/University) levels within India.

Value of Scholarship

The value of scholarship includes the following for complete duration of the course:-

- i. Maintenance allowance,
- ii. Reimbursement of compulsory non-refundable fees,
- iii. Study tour charges,
- iv. Study tour charges,
- v. Thesis typing/printing charges for research scholars.
- vi. Book allowance for students pursuing correspondence courses,
- vii. Book bank facility for specified courses, and
- viii. Additional allowance for students with for the complete duration of the course.

Ten Percent extra allowances shall be provided for Divyang Students Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The applicant should be resident of Delhi.
- Scholarship is available to all SC students whose parents/ guardians income from all sources does not exceed <u>Rs. 2.5 Lakh</u> per annum who are pursuing post matriculation/post secondary (college/university) level studies in Govt. Recognized institution.
- 3. Upload all relevant documents like Aadhaar, Bank details, previous year Mark sheet, original fee receipts, fee structure, income certificate & caste certificate.
- 4. All the children of same family/parents are also eligible subject to the income limit of the parents. Students availing any other scholarship/stipend such as merit scholarship will not be eligible for the scholarship.
- 5. A certificate from the institution to the effect that the student is not getting any other scholarship/stipend.
- 6. Regular attendance record not less than 75% in the previous year should be prerequisite for availing scholarship.

- 7. Date of admission in the course/commencement of class and completion of course.
- 8. Upload a copy of certificate, Diploma, Degree etc. in respect of all previous examination passed.
- 9. Income certificate issued by competent authority (SDM/Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), GNCTD) of Delhi should be valid at the time of submission of application.
- 10. For Institutes situated outside Delhi, the Institute Verification page and parent/guardian verification page should be uploaded by the applicant on E-district portal.
- 11. Upload a copy of Caste certificate issued by the Govt. of NCT of NCT of Delhi.
- 12. Incomplete application will be treated as cancelled without giving any information.
- 13. Hostel rent will be given as per guide lines of the scheme.
- 14. Fee structure should be on the official letter head of concerned institute with stamp and signature of head of institute.
- 15. Candidates who after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. I.Sc. After I.A. or B.Com. After B.A. or M.A. in other subject will not be eligible.
- 16. Students who, after having complete their educational career in one professional line, e.g. L.L.B. after B.T./B.Ed. will not be eligible. From the academic year 1980-81, studies in two professional courses are allowed.
- 17. Scholars will be paid enrolment/registration, tuition, games, Union, Library, Magazine, Medical Examination and such other fees compulsorily payable by the scholar to the institution or University/Board. Refundable deposits like caution money, security deposit will, however, be excluded.
- 18. Follow the guidelines of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. Of India.
- 19. Bank account of the student should be seeded with his/her Aadhaar.
- 20. All eligible Scheduled Caste candidates will be given scholarship as prescribed in this scheme.
- 21. The provisions of this scheme can be changed at any time at the discretion of the Central/State Government.

4. <u>Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme for Students belonging to Scheduled</u> Caste studying in Classes IX & X

(Centrally sponsored Scheme- Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India)

A. Conditions for Scholarship:-

- 1. Students should belong to Scheduled Caste.
- 2. His/Her Parents/Guardian's Income should not exceed Rs. 2.5 Lakh Per annum.
- 3. He/She should not be getting any other centrally/state funded Scholarship.
- 4. The Scholarship will be given to the students of Classes IX and X who are studying in a Government school or in a School recognized by Govt. of a Central/State Board of Secondary Education.
- 5. To be eligible no percentage of marks.
- 6. Upload a copy of Caste Certificate issued by competent Authority should be uploaded on the portal (Performa available on E-district portal), Domicile Certificate of Delhi if the caste certificate is not issued by the competent authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
- 7. The Bank account should be in the name of the students & seeded with Aadhaar of student.
- 8. Income certificate issued by competent authority (SDM/Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), GNCTD) of Delhi should be valid at the time of submission of application.

B. **How to Apply:**

- 1. Applicants should upload Caste Certificate issued in the name of student or his father's name of SDM/Deputy Commissioner (Revenue) GNCTD.
- 2. Domicile Certificate of Delhi, if the Caste (SC) certificate is not issued by the competent authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

- 3. Follow the guidelines of the scheme issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. Of India.
- 4. Bank account of the student should be seeded with his/her Aadhaar.
- 5. All eligible Scheduled Caste candidates will be given scholarship as prescribed in this scheme.
- 6. The provisions of this scheme can be changed at any time at the discretion of the Central/State Government.
